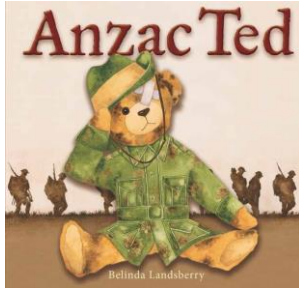

Design and make a local hero medal

What you need:

- Cardboard (cut into the shape of a circle/disc)
 - Writing tools (pen, pencil etc.)
 - Ribbon
 - Hole punch
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- With the help of your parents, brainstorm people in the community who you consider to be everyday heroes.
 - Make a list of skills, traits or achievements that you think make them a hero.
 - Use these ideas to design and draw an image on the cardboard disc.
 - Use the hole punch to create a hole in the disc. Thread the ribbon through the hole, and tie a knot to create a lanyard.
 - Present the medal to your local hero.
